Constellation using the Lemoyne Star Ruler

The Rapid fire construction technique and trim-down tool makes a perfect star from as small as 3" up to 12". Small Stack'n'Whack Wall Hanging

What a delight this jelly roll quilt is to make! It may look intimidating, but the secret is to keep your fabrics separate and organized while stitching and positioning the blocks. I have several ways to easily help you keep order over your fabric strips—and we'll use them all! Using a variety of medium to dark batiks keeps the design from getting lost. Also, choosing and placing fabrics that contrast well with their neighbours, allows the “links” to appear as if they were woven together. Kitchen Sink

What a wonderful way to use a new jelly roll with strong light and dark strips or stash scraps. Anything goes, hence the title everything but the “Kitchen Sink”. The most important fact to remember is to have a strong contrast between the light and dark fabrics. As challenging as it may appear, the quilt is easily completed with blocks on point. Class \$45. Humble Origins

The block in this Tula Pink design is a different take on an old standard. Called the interrupted log cabin, it is a block within a block. In true Tula style, it is injected with pops of bright colour with simple and straightforward piecing. Instructions are well laid out with blocks set on point. You'll be amazed at the final outcome! Merry Medley

Santa is watching! You will not be on the naughty list when you make this easy framed lap quilt or wall hanging. A panel in the centre and some squares and half square triangles around the outside create this labyrinth style quilt. Silver Maple

Would you like to make a paper pieced quilt? This table topper is not a huge project, so you won't have time to be bored; there are just enough paper-pieced blocks to build your confidence. With thirteen 4-inch blocks, your finished accent quilt will be 24 x 30 ½

inches. **There will be precutting**, so you will be prepared to make the blocks in the first class, and the on-point setting with borders and creative quilting in the last class. You will have 2 weeks between classes to complete your blocks. Class \$43. See supply list for extra requirements.



Spiral Table Topper

What to do with all those off-cuts, that is the question. A good friend of mine (a self-confessed *Pinterest* addict) saw this stool idea and she has made quite a few. If you don't generate a good supply of off-cuts, have your quilting friends save some for you or stuff it with good old polyester stuffing. I make my cover, leave one seam open and as I trim, anything too small for another project, goes in. So save up your pieces and bring them to class. Class \$40.
